## **DEBORAH LUEPNITZ, PHD TO PRESENT IN MAY 2009**

The Advanced Psychodynamic Psychotherapy Program Alumni and the St. Louis Psychoanalytic Institute are proud to sponsor a presentation by Deborah Anna Luepnitz, Ph.D., on Friday, May 8, 2009, entitled *Love on the Royal Road: Using Dream Work in Psychotherapy with Couples*.

Dr. Luepnitz is a psychoanalyst in private practice in Philadelphia, as well as a member of the clinical faculty of the Department of Psychiatry at the University Of Pennsylvania School Of Medicine. For Dr. Luepnitz, psychoanalysis informs psychotherapeutic work of all kinds—couples counseling, family therapy and work with the homeless—as much as the individual patient in intensive therapy. Her flexible approach to working analytically, her profound grasp of psychoanalytic literature and her lucid expository style make her a marvelous guide to the application of psychoanalytic theory and technique in any setting.
