A TRIBUTE TO DRS. NATHAN SIMON AND MOISY SHOPPER

Also at the Institute's recent Annual Dinner, Cheryl Lawler paid tribute to **Nathan Simon, MD** and **Moisy Shopper, MD**, two long-time Institute faculty members who recently retired from private practice. Dr. Simon was the first chair of the APP program, and in fact launched the program at Jewish Hospital in 1970 before moving it to the Institute. Cheryl noted that as Chair of the Clinic, Dr. Simon has overseen its growth into what it is today – serving more low-fee patients and offering both graduate and post-graduate Practicum programs.

Dr. Shopper has been written up in the Missouri Law Review for his work in Forensic Psychoanalysis and was the first chair of the CDP program which he launched in 1983. He is currently Chair of the Patient and Colleague Assistance Committee, which is integral to the Institute.
